The lift is out of order, you need to get to the fourth floor. But you've got full hands and you need help with some heavy boxes, ask politely for help.

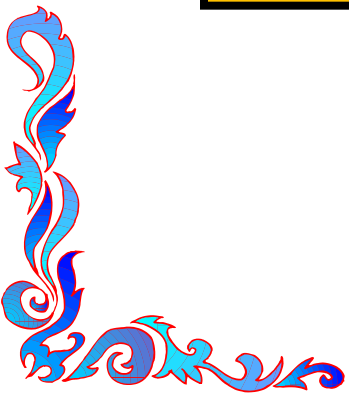


Student B
